Membership Agreement



The York Community Compost Co-Op, supported by the York County Economic Alliance and hosted at the Horn Farm Center, provides residents of York County with an accessible, community-based composting system. Members agree to follow the guidelines below to maintain a safe, clean, and effective composting process for everyone involved.

Member Responsibilities

- 1. **Drop-Off:** Members may drop off approved compostable materials at the designated Horn Farm Center site during operating hours.
- 2. **Materials Accepted:** Fruit and vegetable scraps, coffee grounds, tea bags, eggshells, and other organic matter listed in the member guide. No meat, dairy, or oils.
- 3. **Participation:** Members are encouraged to participate periodically in compost "shifting" and maintenance activities to help the system run smoothly.
- 4. **Collection:** Once compost is fully processed, members may collect a portion for personal or garden use.
- 5. **Respect & Safety:** Members agree to maintain respect for the site, volunteers, and other participants, and to follow safety and hygiene practices while on site.

Program Commitment

The Co-Op is a volunteer-run initiative dedicated to reducing and redirecting food waste, rebuilding soil health, and strengthening community connections. Participation is free and voluntary, and members may discontinue at any time by notifying the Co-Op team.
